All professional development opportunities will be held at Knox County ESC. Registration is on a first-come, first served basis. Courses are free to educators from Knox County schools. Ashland University credit is available for many of the classes at a tuition rate of \$183 per semester hour.

Payment for workshops or school purchase order must be received by KCESC prior to the workshop date for participants from non-client schools. Educators from Centerburg, Danville, East Knox, Fredericktown, or Mount Vernon Schools take workshops FREE of charge, except for Ashland tuition, if desired. Non-client participants pay EITHER the course cost OR Ashland tuition, but not both.
